 - Perform **cabinet modifications/customizations** per work order (examples: trimming/fitting parts, increasing/decreasing depth, drilling/boring, adding fillers/skins, adjusting openings, toe-kick work, hardware/hinge prep).
 - **Read and follow work orders, diagrams, and specifications**, verifying measurements and fit before final assembly.
 - Install or stage components such as **hangers, corner blocks, shelves, doors/skins**, labels, and packaging materials as required by the process.
 - Conduct **quality checks** for squareness, alignment, door/hinge operation, finish protection, and defect identification; rework when needed.
 - Maintain a **clean, safe workstation** and follow all safety procedures when operating hand/power tools and handling materials.
 - Support general warehouse/production needs as assigned (staging, moving product, light material handling).

Previous cabinet assembly experience is very important.

- **2+ years** experience in **cabinet assembly, cabinet modification, woodworking, millwork, or related manufacturing** (preferred; will consider strong comparable experience).
- Proficiency with **hand and power tools** used in cabinet assembly (e.g., drills/drivers, nailers/staplers, measuring/layout tools).
- Ability to **measure accurately**, interpret build instructions, and consistently hit spec.
- Strong attention to detail and pride in craftsmanship; able to work efficiently without sacrificing quality.
